

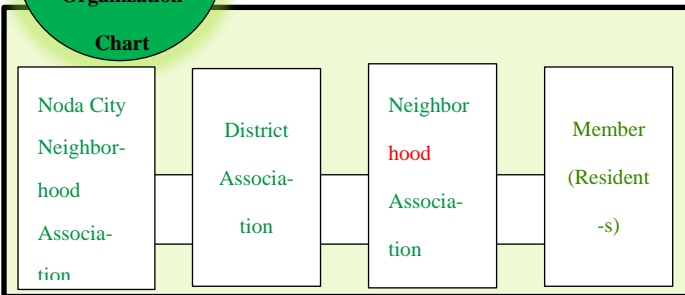
Noda City Neighborhood Association
